At Sense Scotland, we are committed to create independent living opportunities for people with communication support needs, either in their own home or in one of our residential homes.

Set in its own grounds in Glasgow's Southside lays Overbridge, a large Victorian villa where we provide residential care for 9 young adults. Moving out of the family home and into your own place can be daunting. At Overbridge we support you through this transitional challenge. There's no rush, and when you're ready we can help you find a place of your own.

Our facilities

At Overbridge, we provide seven en-suite bedrooms and two individual flats to encourage independence. It's a bright home with an enclosed garden, communal living and dining areas and experienced care and support for 24 hours a day. Overbridge is situated in the heart of leafy Pollokshields, close to shops, cafes and excellent transport links to all parts of the City and beyond. A five-minute bus drive takes you to our Glasgow resource

Touchbase where you can access a range of creative educational and social activities.

You don't need to be supported at your home by Sense Scotland to access our Glasgow resource TouchBase. We can help you build your own programme of support, based on your interests, your needs and your aspirations.
